

5 ½ week field intensive course designed to expand student knowledge of the biodiversity, geochemistry and human impacts on Florida's coastal and offshore ecosystems.

**When?** May 14 - June 20, 2014. Rotating between the home institution, and at various locations around the state of Florida.

Where? Students from any accredited university can enroll as a summer transient student at the Univ. South Florida St Petersburg, Univ. North Florida, Florida Atlantic Univ., Florida Gulf Coast Univ. and the Univ. of West Florida

**Cost?** Varies at each Florida University; Out-of-state rates may apply. A lab fee of \$2,030/student covers room and board plus lab supplies.

**What's Included?** Meals- 5 days/week; housing; transportation at each field site during the week. (Transportation between institutions required and meals on weekends are not included.)

**Interested?** Register at Florida Atlantic University, Florida Gulf Coast University, University of North Florida, University of South Florida St Petersburg, or the University of West Florida.
